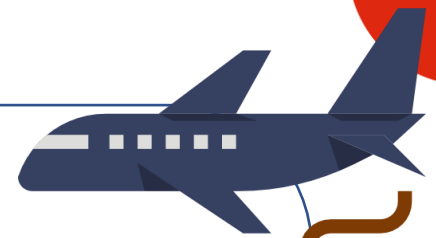

PA 2021: Two “economic engines”

Northern Metropolis

“will be developed as an international I&T hub with unique metropolitan landscape marked with “Urban-Rural Integration and Co-existence of Development and Conservation ... and will in turn facilitate Hong Kong to better integrate into the overall development” of China.

Harbour Metropolis

“supporting Hong Kong’s status as an international financial centre will be expanded to include the reclaimed land of the Kau Yi Chau Artificial Islands under the Lantau Tomorrow Vision”.
