### Significance of policy research

On March 2023, the General Office of the Chinese Communist Party published a document on the significance of policy research, 《关于在全党大兴调查研究的工作方案》.

### **Key messages:**

- ❖ Research empowers the right to speech; research facilities decision-making. Research seeks facts, and influences implementation. Research is the foundation of political work.
- The currency of research escalates in the age of unprecedented changes of global contexts and heightening uncertainties.
- ❖ Research should stem from engagement with citizens, reflect citizens' needs, address citizens' needs.
- Research should be pragmatic and true to realistic conditions; question-oriented and aims at resolving problems. Research results should be turned into actual actions.
- The process of research should grasp both holistic and particular views, current and long-term issues, macro and micro perspectives, major and minor controversies, generic and specific relations, forward-looking thinking and holistic strategies.



## **CEPU Background and Focuses**



### **Background:**

The Chief Executive's Policy Unit (CEPU) has commenced operations **since December 28, 2022**. It was set up following Chief Executive's call in his Policy Address (PA) in October 2022 **to enhance the Government's capabilities in research and advocacy on long-term and strategic issues.**

Long-term and strategic policies

International relations and situations

**National development** 

Social harmony and stability of Hong Kong

### **CEPU Expert Group**

Members of different backgrounds including business, finance, professionals, think-tanks and academia are invited to join the CEPU Expert Group to provide expert views and new ideas to the CEPU concerning various topics.

## **CEPU Funding Schemes**



Aim: Build up external policy research capacity of higher education institutions and think tanks to enhance the Government's capabilities in public policy research and advocacy on long-term and strategic issues.

# Public Policy Research Funding Scheme (PPRFS)

- Applications accepted throughout the year
- Open topics within 8 major themes
- Shorter research duration, usually12 months or less
- Less research funding, usually HK\$1 million or less

# Strategic Public Policy Research Funding Scheme (SPPRFS)

- Applications accepted once a year
- Strategic themes and research areas identified by the Government
- Longer research duration, usually 1-3 years
- ❖ More research funding, usually HK\$1-3 million

  - c) Public Sector Reform
  - d) Achieving Carbon Neutrality
  - e) Hydrogen Economy
  - f) Sustainable Development of Elderly Care Service under an Ageing Population
  - g) Healthcare Innovations in the Post-COVID19 Pandemic Era
  - h) Education



## **Policy Address**



- ❖ In order to tap into local communities and listen to the views and suggestions of member of the public, more than 40 consultation sessions for the 2023 PA were organised within 3 months.
- Public views are also tapped though multiple channels, including emails and social media and more than 8700 pieces of public opinion were collected.

### **Governance Culture**

- **◆** Emphasised "result-oriented" and "chasing time and results" last year
- ◆ Advocate the "industry-oriented approach" this year to lead Hong Kong to new heights as an economy and a community
- ◆ Achieve a better integration of a capable government and an efficient market by setting up 8 deidcated offices and promulgating 8 industry blueprints

- Enhance Three Railways and Three Major Roads proposals, introduce new Two Railways and One Major Road projects

- Promote Fertility and Create a
   Pro-childbearing Environment

### **Uphold "One Country, Two Systems"**


◆ Complete legislation of the Article 23 of the Basic Law, roll out patriotic education
